

Checklist for Instrument Rental

Please bring this sheet with you to the music store!

The following items are required for participation in Band Lessons:

Instrument: Flute, Clarinet, Alto Saxophone, Trumpet,
French Horn, Trombone or Baritone

Percussion: Bell Kit/Drum Pad Combo Set (REQUIRED): All NEW Percussion students will be required to start their studies on Bells as per the Hamilton Township Schools' Music Curriculum. DO NOT PURCHASE A DRUM PAD ONLY. 2ND year students will continue to study both Bells and Drum Pad.

Accessories:

- CLARINET & ALTO SAXOPHONE: At least SIX REEDS -size 2 or 2 1/2 and Cork Grease
 - TRUMPET, FRENCH HORN, TROMBONE, BARITONE: Valve Oil

Music Stand *with* Carrying Bag

For at home practice. Students will be asked to bring stands for lessons when we return to school.

Lesson Book: *Sound Innovations for Concert Band, Book 1*

Check to make sure it is the book for your instrument in the upper right hand corner.

BEFORE YOUR FIRST LESSON!**

Tip: Use a colorful ribbon or brightly colored / designer duct tape to mark your case. This way you can easily identify your instrument!

A note of
advice

****Buyer Beware!** Cheaper, no name instruments often cannot be repaired or serviced at local music stores. This will ultimately lead to more headaches than the instrument is worth. Most instrument rentals include a repair agreement where most repairs are included in the rental fee at no charge.
