



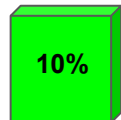

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

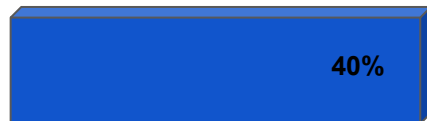

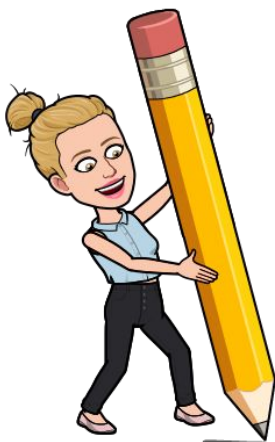
